FREE booster diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis vaccination

Do you give permission?

Dear parent,

Your child can get a vaccine at school against **diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough (Boostrix®)**

- The vaccine protects against 3 diseases.
- This booster vaccine is necessary for long-term protection.

This vaccination is free of charge. It is done by the CLB (Centre for Pupil Guidance).

We ask for your permission. Talk about it with your child. Thanks for cooperating!

About diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough



Diphtheria can cause severe inflammation of the throat and airways. Then there is a danger of suffocation. Sometimes there is also damage to the heart and nerves.

Tetanus blocks the nerves. This causes very painful muscle cramps. As a result, you can sometimes no longer breathe.

Pertussis (whooping cough) causes severe coughing fits and difficult breathing. It is especially dangerous for babies.



We give the vaccine with **1 injection** in the arm.



This is a booster vaccine. The vaccine works for about **10 years**. It is best to get it again every 10 years.



The vaccine is **very safe**. A vaccine can have side effects. Mild side effects of the vaccine go away on their own (fever, abdominal pain, headache, nausea, tired). The chance that this vaccine will cause a serious side effect is very small.



The vaccine is completely **free**.



The vaccination at school is done by a **doctor or nurse** from the CLB. You can also go to your doctor, but the consultation must be paid for.
